 Your letter No. SIMPRA/Affln/002/12, dated 15.10.2012 along with DD for Rs 5,00,000/- (DD No. 248848 dated 13.10.2012, Indian Bank, Thanjore Junction).

I am, by direction, to inform you that the Syndicate of the University, at its meeting held on 10.10.2012 has considered the request of Simpra Institute of Science Technology Education & Research Academy, Thanjavur District for grant of provisional affiliation for starting a new unaided Private (Self-financing) Teachers Education College in the name and style of Simpra College of Education, Plot/Khasara No. 203/2, Street. No. M.C. Road, Rajappa Nagar, Post, Melaveli Village, Thanjavur Taluk, Thanjavur District – 613 007, to offer B.Ed. Degree Course for the academic year 2012-2013 with the students strength of 100, based on (a) the recognition order from the NCTE and (b) the report of the Inspection Commission sent by this University, and resolved to grant conditional provisional affiliation to start a new college of Education in the name and style of Simpra College of Education, Thanjavur District for the academic year 2012-2013 only with a student strength of 100.

In accordance with the resolution of the Syndicate, fresh Conditional Provisional Affiliation is granted to start a new college in the name and style of "Simpra College of Education, Plot/Khasara No. 203/2, Street. No. M.C. Road, Rajappa Nagar, Post, Melaveli Village, Thanjavur Taluk, Thanjavur District, Pin – 613 007" (College Code: 12025) to offer B.Ed. degree course with student strength of 100 for the academic year 2012-2013 only subject to the fulfillment of the conditions laid down for grant of affiliation.

Under no circumstances, fresh admission shall be made to B.Ed. Degree Course during the academic year 2013-2014, until and unless the continuation for Provisional Affiliation is obtained from the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University for the year 2013-2014.

The conditions laid down by this University for affiliation are furnished below which the College should strictly adhere to and any lapse will attract appropriate action under the provision of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University Act.

This affiliation order is issued subject to the condition that the candidates admitted should earn the required attendance and progress to appear for the University Examinations in May/June 2013.

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS SHALL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.

- All the conditions laid down by the NCTE, Bangalore.
- 2. Candidates to be admitted in B.Ed. Degree course shall (a) satisfy the eligibility conditions prescribed in the Regulations and the guidelines to be prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the academic year 2012-2013 (b) obtain approval from the University for the students admitted to B.Ed. degree course as per prescribed norms and (c) earn required attendance prescribed by the University for appearing for the University Examinations.
- The admission of students for B.Ed. Degree Course shall be made in accordance with the guidelines for admission prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu for each academic year. No student shall be admitted for a irregular course for any kind of gratification.
- The Syllabus prescribed by the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University shall be followed. (Copy enclosed)
- The college shall complete the working days prescribed by the University in the Regulations prescribed for B.Ed. course in an academic year.
- Arrangement shall be made by the college for the conduct of University Examinations.
- No donations shall be collected from the students seeking admission to any course of study in the college.
- 8. The Management of College shall not discontinue any existing course without prior permission from the University which should be intimated before the 30th September of the respective academic year.
 - The college shall only collect Tuition and other fees from the students at the rates as prescribed by the State Government / University.

- 10. A Librarian, Physical Director/Directress and a Medical officer with the prescribed qualification shall be appointed.
- 11. Number of teaching and non-teaching staff shall be appointed as per norms prescribed by the University/ U.G.C./NCTE/Government for each course. The post of Principal shall not be kept vacant and qualified Principal shall always be in position.
- 12. No teacher shall be appointed, if he/ she has not fulfilled the qualifications as laid down by the University and U.G.C./NCTE from time to time.
- 13. An agreement shall be entered into with each teacher to be appointed as per the requirements of the University/ Tamil Nadu Private Colleges (Regulation). Act and rules there under.
- 14. The teacher should be paid as per pay scales of UGC/AICTE/NCTE/VI pay commission of the State Government, as the case may be, and their salary should be paid through Banks, by means of Cheques. This will be verified by the authorities from time to time.
- 15. The posts of teacher and Head of the Departments wherever required for the proposed course shall be filled up before starting the course.
- 16. No teacher shall be appointed or shall be continued in service, who has attained the age of superannuation as may be prescribed by the Tamil Nadu Government.
- 17. Suitable leave rules for teaching and Non-teaching staff shall be framed, generally in conformity with the State Government rules.
- 18. Approval shall be obtained from the University before appointing the teaching staff.
- The College shall implement each and every one of the recommendations of the Inspection commission.
- 20. The College shall have [1] Separate lounge [2] Rest room [3] Toilet for Women Faculty.
- 21. The classrooms shall be according to the specification suggested U.G.C./NCTE norms.
- 22. The library should be strengthened, as suggested by the Inspection commission. The library shall have common reading room and stack room as per standard prescribed by the U.G.C. /NCTE/ Government.
- 23.Land Use Certificate, Land Continuity Certificate and Land Classification Certificate obtained from the competent authorities shall be kept ready for verification at any time.
- 24. Fire Service Certificate shall be obtained and renewed and shall be kept ready for verification at any time.
- 25. Laboratory shall be strengthened, as suggested by the Commission. The Laboratory shall have sufficient equipments required for performing experiments prescribed for the courses of study. The laboratories shall also have adequate arrangement for gas supply, regular water supply and electricity. The safety standard shall be fully observed.
- 26. The required area of land and the building shall be in the name of the Trust.
- 27. The College shall obtain Building Plan approval and License from the competent authorities for constructions.

- Certificate under Section 37(B) of Tamil Nadu Land Reforms (Land fixation and Ceiling) Act, 1961, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 10.06.2010.
- 29. Land Area, whether Wet or Dry Land (Wet Land Conversion Certificate issued by Directorate of Town and Country Planning in case if it is Wet Land as per the new Section 47(A) in the Tamil Nadu Town and Country Planning Act 1971, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 01.01.2011.

The Management shall submit the documents required under Sl.Nos. 28 & 29 above on or before 30.04.2013 as decided by the Syndicate.

- 30. The maximum number of students who may be admitted to each of the course shall not exceed the strength sanctioned by the University/NCTE.
- 31. Necessary Hostel accommodation, Staff quarters, Play ground shall be provided.
- Such other Rules and Regulations as may be generally prescribed from time to time by the University shall also be abided by the Management.
- 33. All the conditions shall be abided by the Management and in the event of any violation, the affiliation granted shall be ceased automatically.
- 34. As per the "National Council for Teacher Education, (Recognition Norms and Procedures Amendment)" Regulations 2010 an institution shall be permitted to apply for new course of M.Ed. and B.Ed. (Additional Intake) after it has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with atleast Letter Grade B developed by NAAC.
- The attendance of the staff members and the students shall be effectively monitored and periodical report shall be submitted.
- 36. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per the provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:
 - i. Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution.
 - Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - iii. Names of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
 - iv. Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission etc;
 - v. Fee charged from students;
 - vi. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - vii. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - ix. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so
 - Any wrong or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 37. Minority Certificate from the Principal Secretary, Department of Education, Government of Tamil Nadu to be submitted with 3 months from the date of issue of this order.

The following documents shall be submitted by the Management, within a month. (Vide letter No. TNTEU/R/Affin-Endow/2012/833, dated 12.10.2012).

- 38. Building Plan approved by the President of Village Panchayat.
- 39. Land Use certificate issued by Collector/Tahsildar.
- 40. Pollution Control Certificate from concerned authority.
- 41. Documentary evidence for payment of Infrastructure and amenity charges as per Tamil Nadu Gazette Notification regarding Levy of Infrastructure and Amenities Charges Rules 2008, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 26.01.2008.

Further a copy of Regulations and Syllabus together with the qualifications prescribed for appointment of teachers is enclosed herewith.

One hundred (100) applications for approval of admissions of B.Ed students from the academic year 2012-2013 are enclosed herewith, (bearing Sl. No. 72001 to 72100.)
